Digital Literacy and Innovation for Tomorrow's Education (D- LITE)



Phase I :

Thirty five teachers from colleges of University of Delhi attended the course on “Digital Learning” , designed in collaboration with Edinburgh College, Scotland, UK; under the UK-India education Research Initiative (UKIERI).The course was conducted at Campus of Open Learning, Keshav Puram during 18th -22nd November 2013.

“Four Digital Literacy Champions” were selected for further training in Edinburgh College, Scotland, UK.

Phase II:

Campus of Open Learning, University of Delhi again invites applications from teachers of University of Delhi for the course on Digital Literacy (17th- 19th February, 2015).

The course has been designed to introduce a range of different digital tools, productivity software and digital communication methods and introduces educational practitioners to the concepts and contexts of digital literacy and supports them in developing their own

practice aimed at fostering the components of digital literacy in classroom subject teaching and in real university settings.

Four Participants will be chosen to travel to Edinburgh College, Scotland, as "Digital Literacy Champions", to undertake staff Development for a weeklong workshop. The Trained teachers will assist in delivering this course to the students at Campus of Open Learning, KeshavPuram.

This course is suitable for teachers equipped with basic skills in using computers, who can create a teaching- learning resource in Microsoft applications such as Word/ PowerPoint etc.

Candidates will require access to a range of digital tools for "Digital Literacy for Teachers" course which might include computers (stand-alone, networked, or laptops), hand-held mobile devices like mobile phones, tablets etc. Candidates should also have access to a range of productivity software like word processor, spreadsheet, presentation, audio, video and imaging, and educational software.
